To prevent some of the internal problems that might occur during registration process all application should be started:


"New Incognito window" – for Google Chrome

Using "in Private browsing" option go to http://www.accaglobal.com and click on the "Apply Now" button on the right hand menu as per below screenshot.








Screen 6 – Supporting Documents








Screen 7 - Your Application Summary (Part 1)




