To prevent some of the internal problems that might occur during registration process all application should be started:

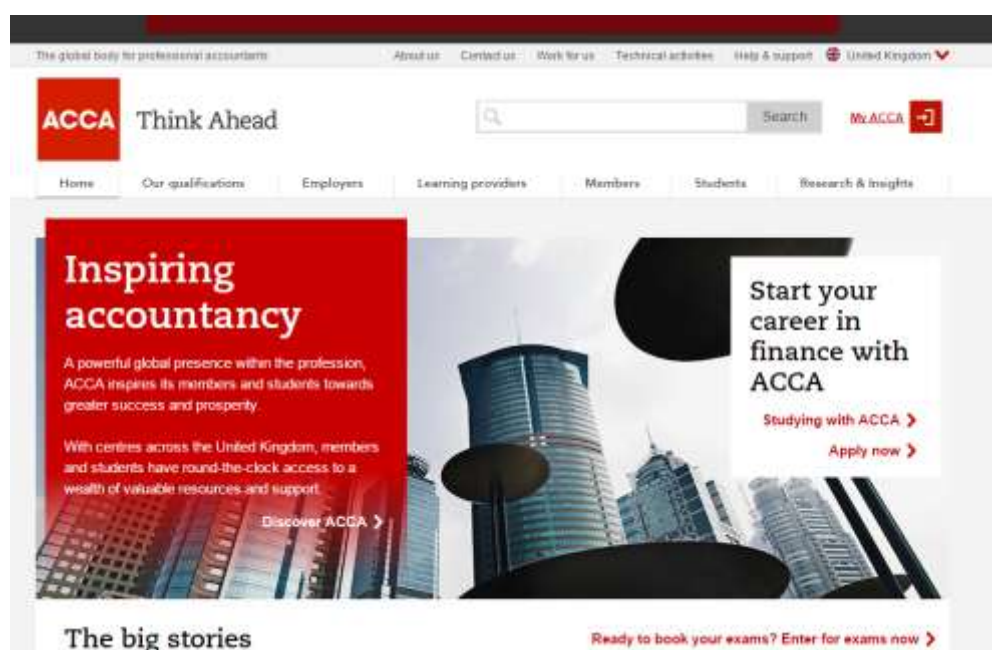
- “New Incognito window” – for Google Chrome

It is recommended by ACCA to use Google Chrome browser when creating online registration.

You may consider giving up exemptions, for instance, if a significant period of time has passed since you gained the qualification. If you do not want to take the exemption offered to you, they can be cancelled by selecting the 'Give Up' button.

**Once an exemption has been given up, you cannot reclaim that exemption based on the same qualification.**

Students eligible for exemption from all or part of the Fundamentals level gained more than five years previously (at the date of initial registration as an ACCA student) should cancel these exemptions and complete the Fundamentals level exams should they wish to subsequently apply for a UK ACCA practising certificate and audit qualification.

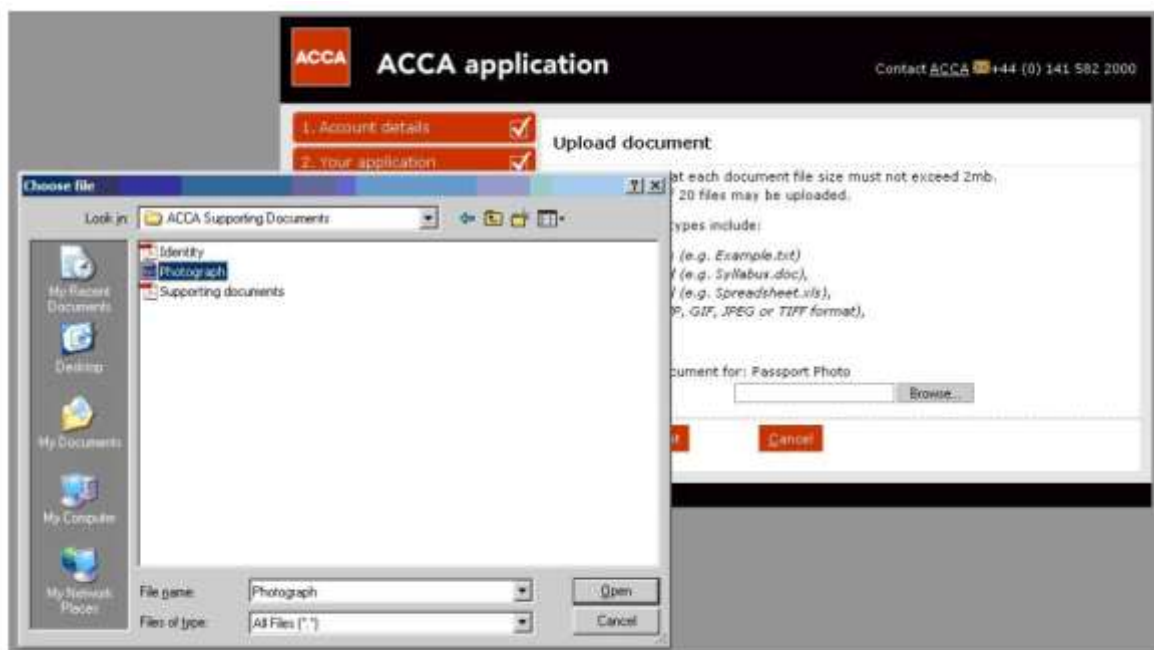

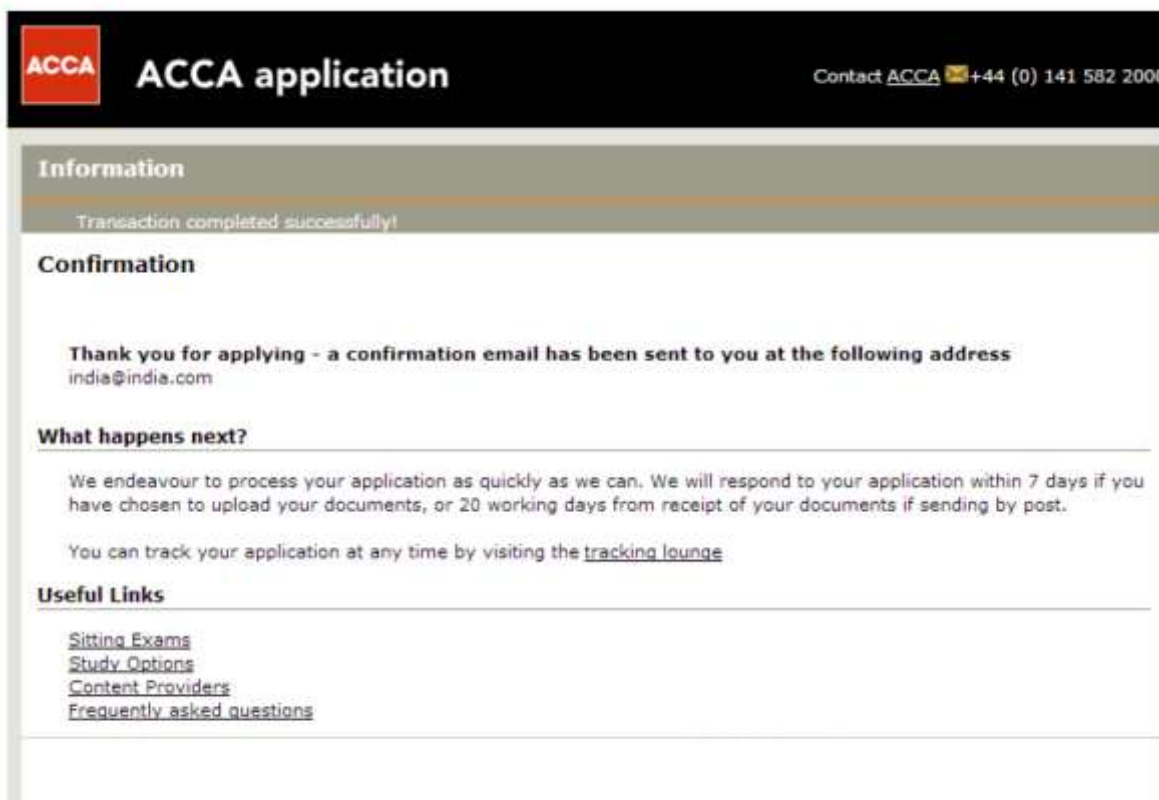
